

DELIVERY MODELS

- **SIOP (Sheltered Instruction Observation Protocol) -** a research-based observation instrument used to measure sheltered instruction
- **PUSH-IN** The push-in provider brings the instruction and any necessary materials to the student.
- **PULL-OUT** Pull-out ESL instruction means that the ESL teacher pulls students out of the general education classroom to work in a small group setting in another room.
- **Co-Teaching** (High School ONLY) Co-Teaching is defined as two teachers (teacher candidate and cooperating teacher) working together with groups of students; sharing the planning, organization, delivery, and assessment of instruction, as well as the physical space.
