Dear FDR Parents,

I hope this letter finds you well as we all continue to move through an unprecedented time. After the school closure, decisions regarding the grading of assignments and promotion to the next grade level were discussed. After much consideration the following decisions have been made about those topics:

- In lieu of grades, course completion will be awarded on a “pass/fail” basis for the remainder of the year. We will utilize a PASS/NO PASS approach for assessment, utilizing only formative assessment with an emphasis on high-quality specific feedback for learning. The threshold for a PASS will be 70%.
  - Students will submit assignments weekly. Teachers will provide feedback for those students who didn't meet the 70% threshold. Students will have the opportunity to resubmit work to demonstrate proficiency.
- When assessing our students' work, what would typically qualify as a 70% or higher will be a passing grade.
- For students who choose not to participate or submit work, a NO PASS grade will be assigned. Our primary focus is student learning. Learning is important and needs to continue.

It is very important that every student is able to participate in at-home learning. If you are not able to access technology, please notify your child's teacher or call 267-599-2300. We will schedule a time to address your technology issues to ensure your child can complete their school work.
